

BIOGRAPHY

Born June 15, 1829 in Schenectady, NY, Dr. Mynderse's family can be traced back to the original Holland Dutch settlers of Albany. He received a BA and MA degree from Union College in 1849. Following his graduation at AMC in 1853, he practiced medicine in Schenectady. He married Albertina S. Ten Broeck and had three children, one of which, Herman Mynderse also graduated from Albany Medical College in 1887. He was a member of the Board of Education from 1869-1887 and served as president the last eight years of that time. He was director of the Mohawk National Bank of Schenectady, a member of the NYS and the Schenectady County Medical Societies, and member of the Holland Society.
