

**Anthony P. Tartaglia, M.D.
Dean 1990-1995**

Dr. Anthony P. Tartaglia became the fifteenth Dean of Albany Medical College in 1990, after a period as interim Dean. He received his B.S. degree in biology from Union College and his medical degree from the University of Rochester Medical School. He served as a physician at Albany Medical Center from 1984-1998, during which time he was also Executive Director of the Albany Medical Center Hospital and Senior Vice President for Patient Care of the Albany Medical Center. Prior to his time at Albany Med. he served as Chief of Medicine at St. Peter's Hospital in Albany from 1975-1984. During his term as Dean he developed an international medical program and directed international medical exchange and education, resulting in the creation of new relationships among institutions across the world. Following his tenure as Dean, Dr. Tartaglia became a Director of Albany Molecular Research Inc. in 1995 and Lead Independent Director in 2005.
